Andrews County Disaster Declaration Directive #3 – Amended and Renewed

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Government Code §418.108 and in accordance with the authority granted the Mayor by the City Council in Resolution 718, the Andrews County Judge and Mayor of the City of Andrews executed Directive #3, Stay Home Stay Safe, on April 4, 2020, taking additional steps to respond to, and mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and to protect the health and welfare of the citizens of Andrews and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas renewed his state-wide disaster proclamation that was first issued on March 13, 2020, certifying that COVID-19 poses an imminent threat of disaster for all counties in the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas issued Executive Order GA-16, effective until April 30th, superseding Executive Order GA-14 confirming the social distancing requirements, limiting social gatherings, extending school closures for in-person classroom attendance for the rest of school year 2019-2020 but also allowing for the re-opening of certain non-essential businesses beginning on April 24, 2020 under certain terms and conditions;

THEREFORE, in accordance with the Executive Order GA-16;

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 418.108, ANDREWS COUNTY JUDGE CHARLIE FALCON ORDERS:

1. THAT Section 1.b. of Directive #3, Stay Home Stay Safe, issued pursuant to the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency for Andrews County and the City of Andrews, is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Section 1.b. and replacing it with the following:

b. Re-opened Businesses

i. Eligible Businesses for Re-opening

In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order GA-16, retail establishments and other businesses not specifically defined as "Essential Businesses" under Directive #3, shall remain closed to the public until 10:01 a.m. April 22, 2020. Beginning at 10:01 a.m. on April 22, 2020, such non-essential retail establishments and businesses may be re-opened in order to provide their goods and services by drive through pickup, delivery by mail, or delivery to the customer's doorstep only. These re-opened businesses shall remain closed to the public and customers and patrons are prohibited from entering the re-opened establishments. All re-opened businesses shall:

A. strictly comply with the terms required by the Texas Department of State Health Services and follow federal and CDC guidelines including taking affirmative steps to ensure that social distancing of 6 feet is maintained between all employees to the extent possible;

B. allow only those employees at the re-opened business establishment necessary to:

- I facilitate online sales, call-in sales, drive through pickup, delivery by mail, or customer delivery services;
- II perform operations necessary to maintain security, payroll, upkeep, and maintenance of premises, equipment or inventory, including but not limited to the care and maintenance of livestock or animals;
- III perform IT or other operations that facilitate employees working remotely from home; or
- IV perform in-store repair services

ii. **Additional Requirements**

A. The local health department may require additional sanitation, signage, and social distancing practices for any business which remains open.


B. For any workplace that remains open, management of the business should facilitate and encourage practicing social distancing and good hygiene and, where feasible, require employees to work from home in order to achieve optimum isolation from COVID-19; and

C. The County Judge and City Mayor may update the restrictions set out in this order as necessary to respond to the evolving circumstances of this outbreak during the duration of the Declaration of Local Disaster as extended by the Commissioners Court of Andrews County and the City Council of the City of Andrews.


2. THAT all other terms and conditions of Directive #3 not specifically amended herein are hereby continued and affirmed.

3. THAT this amendment of Directive #3 shall go into effect immediately upon execution and Directive #3, as clarified, shall continue until 11:59 p.m., May, 21st, 2020 or until it is rescinded, superseded or amended pursuant to applicable law.
