

NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING



There will be a Special Meeting of Andrews County Commissioners Court on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 beginning 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Room 107, Andrews County Courthouse, Andrews, Texas. The purpose of this meeting will be to consider the following agenda:

1. Call to Order

4. Approve the minutes from the previous meetings of Commissioners Court held on February 8 and February 11, 2016.
5. Discuss and consider approving the proposal from Lipham Asphalt and Paving Co., LLC in the amount of \$2,135,065.15 for the 2016 Andrews County TxDOT Transportation Infrastructure Fund Contract No. CTIF-01-002.
6. Discuss and consider accepting a \$300.00 donation from the Permian Basin Foundation to assist in funding the annual TVFC conference for the Andrews County Health Department.
7. Discuss and consider approving the transfer of Matthew Knake from Greenskeeper 1 to Greenskeeper Asst. at the rate of \$22.41 per hour effective March 1, 2016.
8. Discuss and consider approving an Interlocal Cooperation contract between Andrews County and the Texas Department of Public Safety to purchase supplies for the intoxilyzer breath testing and the Laboratory Alcohol and Drug Testing Program effective September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2017.

Discuss and consider approving an order prohibiting weapons from being brought into the courthouse, courthouse annex and affected buildings including handguns possessed by a handgun licensee, whether concealed or openly carried, excepting licensed peace officers or others expressly authorized to carry a gun in courts or court offices by statute; providing for the erections of signs. 11. Consider approving the various budget amendments for the 2015-2016 Budget years under Local Government Code 111.010(d).
