**Proper Clothing Required.** All persons entering the courtroom should be dressed in clothing reasonably befitting the dignity and solemnity of the court proceedings.

JUROR'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

**Right to Reemployment:** A private employer may not terminate the employment of a permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror. An employee whose employment is terminated in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return. (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001).

**Failure to Answer Summons and Provision of False Information:** A person who fails to comply with this summons, or who knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption or to be excused from jury service, is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 (Government Code, Section 62.0141). Additionally, a person shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 if the person: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to this summons without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service. (Government Code, Section 62.11 1).

**Exempt or Disqualified:** You do not need to appear in person if you are exempt or not qualified for jury service. To claim an exemption or report your disqualification, you must complete the following form below, sign it and mail or personally bring it immediately in the enclosed envelope. A person claiming a disqualification or exemption based on the lack of citizenship or lack of residence in the county might no longer be eligible to vote in the county.

**GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE**  
(Gov't Code, Section 62.102)

A person is disqualified to serve as a petit juror unless the person:

1. is at least 18 years of age
2. is a citizen of the United States;
3. is a resident of this state and of the county in which the person is to serve as a juror;
4. is qualified under the constitution and laws to vote in the county in which the person is to serve as a juror;
5. is of sound mind and good moral character;
6. is able to read and write;
7. has not served as a petit juror for six days during the preceding three months in the county court or during the preceding six months in the district court;
8. has not been convicted of misdemeanor theft or a felony; and
9. is not under indictment or other legal accusation for misdemeanor theft or a felony.

If you claim a disqualification or exemption due to lack of US Citizenship, you will no longer be eligible to vote if you fail to provide proof of citizenship.

**EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY SERVICE**  
(Gov't Code, Section 62.106)

A person qualified to serve as a petit juror may establish an exemption from jury service if the person:

1. is over 70 years of age;
2. has legal custody of a child younger than 12 years of age and the person's service on the jury requires leaving the child without adequate supervision;
3. is a student of a public or private secondary school;
4. is a person enrolled and in actual attendance at an institution of higher education;
5. is an officer or an employee of the senate, the house of representatives, or any department, commission, board, office or other agency in the legislative branch of state government
6. is the primary caretaker of a person who is unable to care for himself or herself;
7. is a member of the United States military forces serving on active duty and deployed to a location away from the person's home station and out of the person's county of residence.

You are not required to claim an exemption, it is your choice.
